Safeguarding Statement of Intent

- Educate students on staying safe and to recognise behaviour that is not acceptable.
- Identify and create provision for any child that has been subject to abuse.
- Ensure that the school owner, Instructors & Helpers understand their responsibility, under safeguarding legislation and statutory guidance, to be alert to the signs of child abuse.
- Ensure that the school owner and any instructors are only appointed when all the appropriate legal checks are complete.

Safeguarding and child welfare protection includes:

- Protecting children from mistreatment.
- Preventing the disruption of children's health or development.
- Ensuring that children grow up with the provision of safe and effective care.
- Taking action to enable all children to have the best outcomes.

Other areas of Care and Education includes:

- Children's and learners' health and safety & well-being.
- Use of reasonable force where applicable.
- Meeting the needs of children and learners with medical conditions.
- Provision of first aid.
- Online safety awareness.
- Ensuring children's and learners' security.
